

Westbourne College Sydney – Scholarship Terms and Conditions

1. Introduction

These Terms and Conditions apply to all scholarships offered by Westbourne College Sydney (“the College”). By applying for or accepting a scholarship, applicants and recipients agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.

2. Eligibility

- Scholarships are awarded solely on merit.
- Financial circumstances are **not** considered in the allocation of scholarships.
- Applicants must meet the entry requirements of the College and comply with all application and assessment procedures as outlined during the scholarship process.

3. Number and Value of Scholarships

- The number of scholarships offered each year is at the absolute discretion of the Principal of Westbourne College Sydney.
- The value or percentage of tuition fees covered by each scholarship will vary and is determined on a case-by-case basis.
- The details of individual awards, including the amount awarded, are confidential and will not be disclosed publicly.

4. Duration of Scholarships

- Scholarships are normally awarded for the duration of a student’s enrolment at the College, unless otherwise specified in the scholarship offer.
- Continuation of a scholarship is subject to the recipient maintaining the academic and behavioural standards expected by the College.

5. Conditions of Scholarship

- Recipients must:
 - Maintain a high standard of academic achievement.
 - Demonstrate commitment to the values and ethos of Westbourne College Sydney.
 - Act as positive ambassadors for the College, including participation in College events where requested.
- Failure to meet these conditions may result in the scholarship being reviewed or withdrawn at the discretion of the Principal.

6. Non-Transferability

- Scholarships apply only to tuition fees at Westbourne College Sydney.

- They are not transferable to another student, another year level, or another institution.

7. Review and Withdrawal

- The College reserves the right to review a student's scholarship at any time.
- A scholarship may be withdrawn if the recipient fails to uphold academic performance, engagement, or behavioural standards, or if there is any breach of College policies.

8. Final Decision

- All decisions regarding the award, continuation, or withdrawal of scholarships rest solely with the Principal of Westbourne College Sydney.
- No correspondence or appeal will be entered into.
